If you have substantial previous experience as a marshal or official of motor sport please complete the 'New Members Experience Record' on pages 3 & 4. This will enable your Regional Committee to grade you accordingly. On acceptance by the Committee you will receive the appropriate badge together with a Grading Card and information to enable you to progress further.

The Club was formed in 1957 with a number of objects in mind:

1. To assist upon request any Race Promoting Club or Organisation requiring officials in any capacity at any motor sporting event in Great Britain run under an MSA. or ACU Permit.
2. To attract ALL experienced Motor Race Officials and also to train inexperienced volunteers in these duties.
3. To improve, where possible, the standard of marshalling and marshalling services
4. To improve the general welfare organisation for Marshals on duty at events
5. To provide automatically from the membership fee, extra insurance cover for volunteer members (between 16 and 70 years of age) while on duty at any authorised event throughout Britain. Details available from Regional Secretary on application.
6. To organise various events of our own (motoring and social), with a view to increasing camaraderie between members.

The British Motor Racing Marshals Club and its associate club the British Rally Marshals Club organise and administer training and grading schemes for Race Marshals, Road and Stage Rally Marshals, Kart Marshals and Speed Event Marshals (Hill Climbs, Sprints, Autocross etc.). Within these schemes are opportunities to train for a wide variety of posts. All grades and posts are open equally to both men and women. Our membership ranges from Novices to Senior Officials in all branches of the sport both at home and overseas. We are affiliated to the Royal Automobile Club, Motor Sports Association (MSA) and enjoy its support and co-operation, together with that of the many other affiliated clubs and the Motoring Press.
